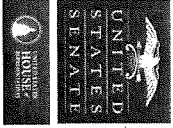
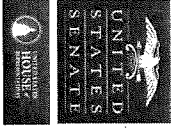

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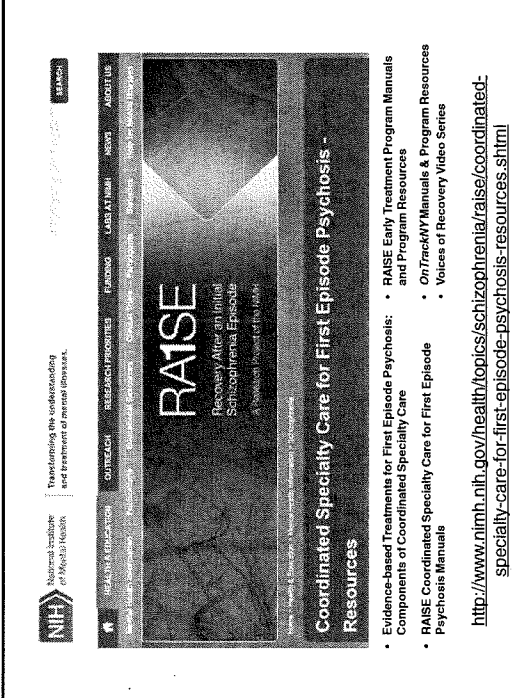

## H.R. 3547, 113th Congress

**January 17, 2014**

- Increased Community Mental Health Block Grant (CMHBG) program by \$24.8M
- Funds allocated for first episode psychosis (FEP) programs
- NIMH and SAMHSA to develop guidance for States regarding effective programs for FEP



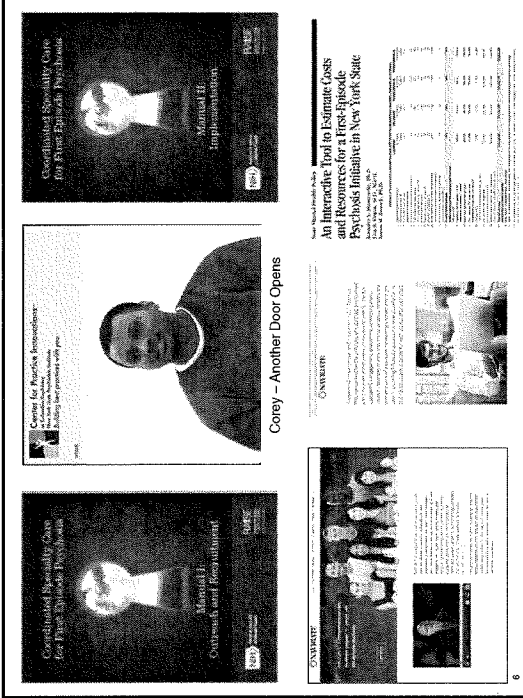

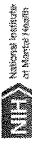

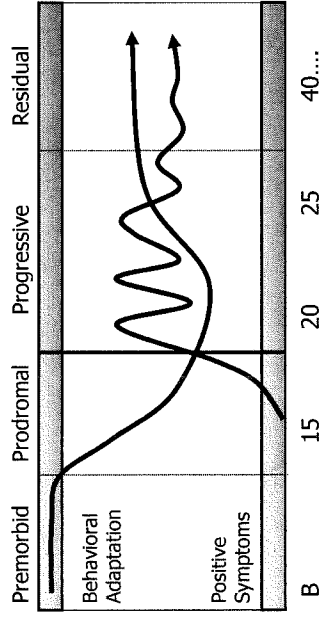

What do we know about preventing psychosis onset?

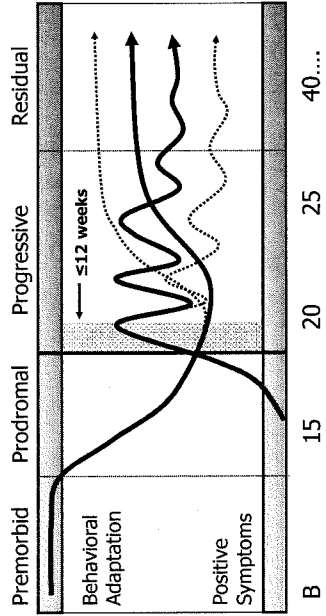


### Clinical course of schizophrenia

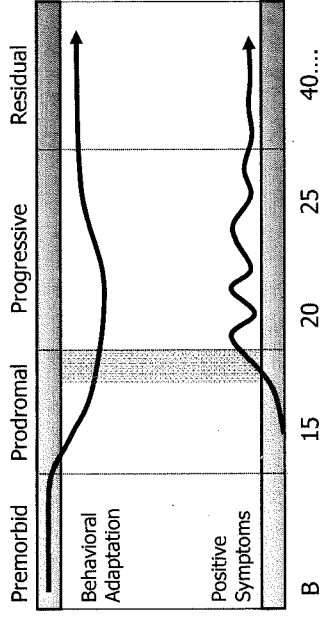

**Early interventions to prevent psychosis: systematic review and meta-analysis**

Magyar K, Stafford, Hannah Jackson, Euan Mape-Jones, Anthony P Johnson, Tim Kendall

- 11 randomized control trials
  - 4 CBT vs. supportive counselling/monitoring
  - 3 CBT + Risperidone vs. comparison group
  - 2 pharmacotherapy (olanzapine, amisulpride)
  - 1 omega-3 fatty acid vs. placebo
  - 2 integrative therapy vs. comparison group
- 1,246 participants



**Research to Improve the Care of Persons at Clinical High Risk for Psychotic Disorders**

- Goals (FFA-MH-14-210/211/212):
  - Test the effectiveness of interventions targeting symptomatic and functional difficulties associated with clinical risk states for psychosis
  - Test hypotheses regarding intervention mechanisms of action
  - Create an evidence base to inform stepped-care models of early psychosis treatment
  - Determine feasibility for implementing approaches in community treatment settings

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**Evidence-Based Care for CHR**

Comparison	# Trials	Quality of Evidence	12-month Transition to Psychosis	Risk Ratio
Cognitive Behavioral Therapy vs. Supportive Counseling	4	Moderate	CBT < SC	0.54
Integrated Psychotherapy vs. Standard Treatment	1	Low	IP < ST	0.24
Omega-3 Fatty Acids vs. Placebo	1	Low	Ω-3 < Placebo	0.18

**Where more data are needed:**

- Early identification and rapid referral from schools, primary care, and child/young mental health programs
- Reliable, sustainable, and scalable methods for diagnosing psychosis risk states in community clinic settings
- Risk stratification and targeted interventions to interrupt symptom progression
